DIAMOND AND TANZANITE DRESS RING

(Stamped 14K) 14ct White gold

The tanzanite is two claw chelier set centrally and vertically. Diamonds are micro-claw set in three split rows forming flared shoulders. The flat lower shank measures 1.83mm wide at the base and 3.77mm wide at the shoulders. This item is of cadcam manufacture. Size M $\frac{3}{4}$. 3.56 grams.

This valuation is based upon a tradition bricks and mortar retail store. The diamond weights, colour and clarity are estimated, exact measurements could not be obtained due to setting limitations.

Diamonds: Round Brilliant cut: 2 = 0.01 carats total estimated weight, measuring 1.10mm, Colour I-J, Clarity SI

Tanzanite: Marquise cut: 1 = 0.51 carats total estimated weight, measuring 8.93x4.22x2.56mm

Colour: Moderate bluish violet

Clarity: Minor visible inclusions.
