Item 1

One lady's, hand finished, raised 14ct yellow gold & diamond set, dress ring, of cast construction. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measure, 1.31mm width (at base) x 0.86mm depth, with cut-out underrail, open back setting, underneath.

Feature, "solitaire style" ring design. Comprising, a raised four claw setting to top. Houses one pear-shaped, rose cut diamond, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up to the top, from both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "14K" - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

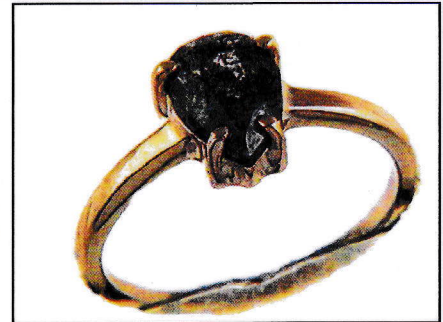
Finger size = I.

The ring contains;

One claw set pear-shaped, rose cut, diamond, clarity is "P3", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 7.87mm (L) x 5.43mm (W) x 2.46mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.63ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 1.74 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.63ct, Total Metal Weight = 1.61 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. The diamond is pear-shaped, rose cut, and is of a low commercial quality grade, and valued accordingly. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamond are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
