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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's, hand finished raised, 9ct white gold & gemstone set, cluster style dress ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.91mm width (at base) x 1.43mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature, "cluster style" ring design, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting to centre. Drops to a bead set surround. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up to the top, from both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "9ct ---" - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size = N.

The ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond/moissanite, colour is "opaque/black", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 6.69mm (Diameter) x 3.59mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 1.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Thirty bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si to P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.20mm (average diameter) x 0.73mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 1.60mm (average diameter) x 0.98mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.45ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 3.50 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.45ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.21 grams (estimated)

Note Limited gemmological testing, inset. The black gemstone may possibly be treated black diamond or treated synthetic black moissanite. Limited testing, whilst set, cannot determine the nature of this gemstone. Therefore, the black gemstone require removal from their settings for full and accurate gemmological testing, by the Australian gem testing laboratory. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
