## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 14ct yellow gold, gem set, flexible link bracelet, of hand-assembled construction.

Feature alternating rectangle links comprising, one link with three round natural rubies, in a row, and claw set (x10) and one link with two round natural rubies, channel set (x11). There a re a total of fifty-two round rubies. The bracelet is finished with a box clasp and two figure 8 safety catches.

Bracelet dimensions = 17.00cm (ave. length) x 3.47mm (ave. width) x 4.67mm (ave. depth).

Polished finish. Stamped '70' - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

The bracelet contains:

Thirty claw set round natural rubies, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 2.44mm(Dia) x 1.49mm(D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.81mm(Dia) x 1.71mm(D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 2.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Two channel set oval shaped natural rubies, colour is "red".

Dimensions (average) = 2.58mm(L) x 1.85mm(W) x 1.13mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.88ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 10.02 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 3.28ct Total Metal Weight = 9.36 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar bracelet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
