Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, flexible link, diamond set necklet.

Feature open back, multi-claw pendant setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond (smallest), sunken set to the centre, surrounded by four round brilliant cut diamonds (largest), claw set. Articulated from the bail assembly.

The chain being of a fine, filed 'curb' style design, having a small 'parrot' type clasp fitted.

Polished finish - stamped '9K MHJ' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Chain dimensions = 39.00cm (length including clasp) x 1.00mm (width). Pendant dimensions = 11.00mm (length including bail) x 5.34mm (ave. width) x 3.96mm (ave. depth).

The necklet contains:

Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'P1', colour 'H to I' (mixed). Dimensions (average) = 2.12mm(Dia) x 1.29mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.15ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

One sunken set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'P1', colour 'I'. Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.03ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 1.88 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.18ct - Total Metal Weight = 1.85 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar necklet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
