Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.17mm width (at base) x 0.91 mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, and a curved underrail.

Feature central round white gold top plate within a six claw setting, housing seven round brilliant cut diamonds, largest to the centre, and claw set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between the extended and 'wrap around' style shoulders of the plain and polished yellow gold band. Each of the shoulders, houses two rows with a total of thirty-nine tapered baguette cut diamonds, graduating in size, and channel set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.

Polished finish. Stamped 'SPK 750' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: S.

The ring contains:

Seven claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H".

Dimensions = 2.32mm(Dia) x 1.42mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.77mm(Dia) x 1.69mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.34ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty Nine channel set tapered baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.51mm(L) x 0.95mm(W) x 0.69mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.03mm(L) x 1.35mm(W) x 0.99mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.66ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 7.61 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct Total Metal Weight = 7.41 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The underrail is cracked in one area. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
