Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand finished, raised 18ct yellow gold & gemset, multistone ring. Plain, wide, low half round, tapered band, measures 3.89mm width (at base) x 1.59mm depth, with open back, underneath.

Feature, "cluster style" ring sdesign, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a trilogy rub-over setting to top centre, houses three round brilliant cut diamonds, rub-over set. Drops to a paritail circular surround, containseight round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up, splits to a v-shaped end termination, each shoulder containing twelve round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "18ct" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = P1/2.

The ring contains;

One rub-over set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "brown tint", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 5.20mm (average diameter) x 3.07mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two rub-over set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "tint light brown".

Dimensions = 4.00mm (average diameter) x 2.44mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.46ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Thirty Two claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si, P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.40mm (average diameter) x 0.85mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.95mm (average diameter) x 1.20mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.54ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.72 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.50ct, Total Metal Weight = 6.42 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
