Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand finished raised, 9ct white gold & diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, wide, low half round, tapered band, measures 3.03mm width (at base) x 1.32mm depth, with curved underrail, open back shoulder settings, underneath.

Feature, "cluster style" ring design, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw illusion setting to top, houses one round brilliant cut diamond, top centre, surrounded by nine round brilliant cut diamonds, grouped together all claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band taper up to pointed end terminations, Each shoulder contains, four round brilliant cut diamonds, graduation in size, channel set, both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "375, JP88" - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size = O.

the ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Vs", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.80mm (diameter) x 2.32mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Nine claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.71mm (average diameter) x 1.04mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Eight channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.04mm (average diameter) x 1.24mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.30mm (average diameter) x 1.40mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.22ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 4.41 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.60ct, Total Metal Weight = 4.29 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
