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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.31mm width (at base) x 0.89mm depth, with hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature pear shaped top plate, housing eight white gold illusion settings, varying in size, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond, illusion set. Surrounding is one row of twenty-five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is supported with a decorative pierced base, and is secured to the underrail and in between the 'split' style shoulders, of the plain and polished yellow gold band. Each of the shoulders houses eleven round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, claw set.



Polished finish. Stamped '9ct' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: P.

The ring contains:

Eight illusion set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P3", colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.40mm(Dia) x 1.46mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.35ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Forty Seven claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2-P3", colour is "H-I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.40mm(Dia) x 0.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.85mm(Dia) x 1.13mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.65ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.72 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct Total Metal Weight = 3.50 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
