Item 1

One lady's, hand finished raised 18ct yellow gold & rhodium plated to highlight, diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.47mm width (at base) x 1.16mm with curved underrail. Feature "trilogy style" ring design, with wall & shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised white rhodium claw setting to top, houses three Princess cut diamonds, claw set. Two round brilliant cut diamonds, rub-over set to each wall side. The extended shoulders, of the yellow gold band tapers up with a channel end termination. Each shoulder containing seven baguette cut diamonds & tapered baguette cut diamonds (mixed), channel set both sides. Polished finish, stamped "750 AC10" - acid tested as 18 carat gold, Finger size = S.



the ring contains;

One claw set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "Vs", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 4.11mm (L) x 4.00mm (W) x 2.40mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.32ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two claw set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Average dimensions = 3.13mm (L) x 3.03mm (W) x 1.82mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Fourteen channel set tapered baguette cut & baguette cut diamonds (mixed), clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Average dimensions = 1.70mm (L) x 0.82mm (W) x 0.60mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.14ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two rub-over set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.00mm (average diameter) x 0.61mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.01ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 5.14 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.75ct, Total Metal Weight = 4.99 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
