## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One lady's, hand finished raised, 18ct white gold & gem set, solitaire ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.38mm width (at base) x 0.85mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature, "solitaire style" ring design. Comprising a raised four claw setting, houses one Princess cut diamond (laser inscribed), claw set. The extended shoulders, of the plain band taper up, to pointed end terminations to both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "18K michael hill, H45031" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Finger size = 0.

The ring contains;

One claw set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 4.57mm (L) x 4.36mm (W) x 3.04mm (D-estimated) x 3.2% (Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.51ct (known weight - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.52 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.51ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.42 grams (estimated)

NOTE: No certification presented at the time of this valuaion. The Princess cut diamond has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Australian Diamond Grading Laboratory, Certificate no. H45031. Dated; 07th November 2013. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with ADGL (logo) and H45031, michael hill.
