## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, hand assembled, 18ct white gold, multi-stone, ring set, of cast construction.

The set comprising a 18ct white gold diamond set engagement ring with a matching 18ct white gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 4.45mm x 1.07mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a central square top plate, housing five round brilliant cut diamonds, smallest diamond to the centre, claw set. Surrounding is one floating row of sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between the extended and square shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The matching wedding ring has one row of fifteen round brilliant cut diamonds, spanning acros sthe top of the band, claw set. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish. Stamped 750 AC16' - acid tested as 18 carat gold, Ring size: S.

The ring contains:

Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.95mm(Dia) x 1.80mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.44ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Forty Two claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.56ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 9.48 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00t Total Metal Weight = 9.26 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
