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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct white gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.30mm width (at base) x 1.04mm depth, with hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and curved cut out underrail.

Feature central raised square top plate, within a four claw setting, housing four Princess cut diamonds, invisibly set. Surrounding is one row of sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured between the 'tri split' style shoulders. Each of the extended and square shoulders has one horizontal row of three baguette cut diamonds, and four horizontal rows of two round brilliant cut diamonds, slightly graduated in size and channel set. There are two fixed rails on either side of the central band, each housing eighteen round brilliant cut diamonds, also graduating in size, largest to the center, and claw set.

Polished finish. Stamped '9K' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: N.

The ring contains:

Four invisibly set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "I".

Dimensions = 2.30mm(L) x 2.30mm(W) x 1.63mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Sixty Eight claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.14mm(Dia) x 0.7mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.50mm(Dia) x 0.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.66ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Six channel set baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.97mm(L) x 1.13mm(W) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.06ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.20 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct Total Metal Weight = 4.00 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
