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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, lady's, hand-assembled raised 18ct white gold & diamond set, solitaire style ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.18mm width (at base) x 1.08mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature, "illusion solitaire style" ring, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised six claw setting, with illusion plate, houses one early brilliant, illusion claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up both sides to the top, with a leaf motif to each side, contains one single cut diamond (chipped), bead set.



Polished finish, stamped "18CT PALL" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Finger size = S1/2.

One illusion claw set early brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.13mm (Diameter) x 1.97mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two bead set single cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.15mm (average diameter)

Total Weight = 0.01ct (estimated - see NOTF below).

Total Item Weight = 3.30 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.13ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.27 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
