One, 18ct white gold, gem set, multistone, pendant of cast construction.

Feature central south sea cultured pearl, surrounded with one undulating row of twenty-eight tapered baguette cut diamonds, alternating with clusters of round brilliant cut diamonds. There are a total of sixteen round brilliant diamonds, claw set. The top plate is supported with an underrail.

Pendant dimensions = 18.06mm (ave. length) x 17.29mm (ave. width) x 15.25mm (ave. depth).

Polished finish. Unstamped.

The pendant contains:

One end-drilled round South Sea cultured pearl, colour is "gold".
