Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct white gold, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.85mm width (at base) x 1.38mm depth, with a curved underrail.

Feature central raised four claw setting, housing one cushion cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one row of sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between the extended and square shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of ten round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set.



Polished finish. Stamped '14K michael hill 40013400103 1.43' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: I 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set cushion cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "I".

Dimensions = 5.62mm(L) x 5.61mm(W) x 3.91mm(D-estimated) x 6%(Girdle Thickness)
