Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, pair of lady's hand-assembled raised, 18ct white gold & gemstone set, circular hoop earrings.

Feature, "hoop style" earrings. Each comprising, triple row to front, the centre row houses ten round, faceted natural rubies, channel set. The two outer rows contain thirty four round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Open & cut out to the back. The hoop earrings, both with hinged base, clip & post fittings attached.

Polished finish, stamped "750" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Earring dimensions = 15.00mm (length) x 3.90mm (width) x 1.99mm (depth).

The item contains:

Twenty channel set round natural rubies, colour is "medium dark red".
Dimensions = 1.65mm (average diameter) x 1.01mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Sixty Eight claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 0.89mm (average diameter) x 0.54mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 3.88 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.60ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.76 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar pair of hoop style earrings, employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
