Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's hand crafted raised, 18ct yellow and white gold, diamond set, bar brooch.

Feature, "cluster style" bar brooch. Comprising, a white gold cluster setting to centre, houses one oval-shaped, faceted diamond, claw set. Dros to a surround contains ten round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. To each side containing one round brilliant cut diamond, rub-over set in yellow gold. The broch having open back settings, underneath. Fitted to one end a hinged brooch pin with a roll-over clasp closure, attached to bach top centre one safety chain with pin.



Polished finish, stamped "18ct" - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Brooch dimensions = 48.00mm (total length) x 10.00mm - 3.64mm (width) x 8.09mm - 1.61mm (depth).

The brooch contains:

One claw set oval-shaped, faceted, diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "H/I"(inset), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 7.09mm (L) x 4.60mm (W) x 3.49mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.75ct(estimated - see NOTE below).

Ten claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si, P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.40mm (average diameter) x 1.46mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.70mm (average diameter) x 1.65mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.60ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two rub-over set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.30mm (average diameter) x 2.01mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.27ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.37 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.62ct, Total Metal Weight = 6.05 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar brooch employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
