Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and 18ct white gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.78mm width (at base0 x 0.90mm depth, with a curved underrail.

Feature central round raised white gold top plate within a four claw setting, housing thirteen round brilliant cut diamonds, largest to the centre, medium and smallest diamonds alternating to the edge. Surrounding is one row of twenty round brilliant cut diamonds. The top plate is supported with a decorative pierced gallery, and in between the extended and pointed shoulders, of the plain and polished yellow gold band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of four brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size. All diamonds are claw set.



Polished finish. Stamped '750 JP02' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: M 1/2.

The ring contains:

Fifteen claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.77mm(Dia) x 1.69mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.77ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Six claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.10mm(Dia) x 0.67mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.23ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.32 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct Total Metal Weight = 4.12 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
