One, hand-assembled, 9ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring.

Plain, narrow, tapered band of 2.06mm in width (at base) x 1.05mm depth.

Feature central six claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Secured in the top of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having five round brilliant cut diamonds,

Polished finish - stamped '375' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size is J.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'P1', colour 'H'. Dimensions = 4.00mm(Dia) x 2.44mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.25ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Ten channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'G to H' (mixed). Dimensions (average) = 1.40mm(Dia) x 0.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.13ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.14 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.38ct - Total Metal Weight = 2.06 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
