Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 2.26mm width (at base) x 0.91mm depth, with open back (cut out) settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central upswept four claw setting, housing one Princess cut diamond, claw set. There is one row of fifteen round brilliant cut diamonds, spanning across the top of the band, underneath the central setting, and channel set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.

Polished finish.

Stamped '750 Hardy Brothers makers mark' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: L.

The ring contains:

One claw set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "G".

Dimensions = 3.67mm(L) x 3.49mm(W) x 2.48mm(D-estimated) x 8%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.24ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifteen channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.65mm(Dia) x 1.01mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.26ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.00 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct Total Metal Weight = 3.90 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
