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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's hand-assembled raised, 14ct white gold & diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.98mm width (at base) x 1.51 mm depth, with curved underrail, open back settings, underneath.

Feature, "square shaped cluster" style setting to top, with u-shaped rail & shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting, with u-shaped rails, contains a total of twenty nine round brilliant cut diamonds, various sizes, all claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up to the top, with a millgrain edge, each shoulder housing, five round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering down, claw set, both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "585" - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Finger size = O.

The ring contains;

Seven claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 2.70mm (average diameter) x 1.65mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 3.36mm (average diameter) x 2.05mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Thirty Two claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.40mm (average diameter) x 0.85mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 2.11mm (average diameter) x 1.29mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 4.18 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.98 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamond are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
