Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand finished raised, 18ct rose gold & gemset, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.87mm width (at base) x 1.54mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature, "solitaire style" ring design, with undercarriage & shoulder set stones. Comprising, a raised four claw sett to top, houses one oval-shaped, faceted, diamond (laser inscribed & certified), claw set. Underneath diamond set rails & support wires, bead set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up, each shoulder triple row diamond bead set, both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "DX 18ct 73704" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = H.

The ring contains;

One claw set oval-shaped, faceted diamond, clarity is "Vs1", colour is "E", ex & very good cut quality.

Dimensions = 7.11mm (L) x 5.22mm (W) x 3.34mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.80ct (known weight - see NOTE below).

Ninety Six bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 0.90mm (average diameter) x 0.55mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.30mm (average diameter) x 0.79mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.48ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.26 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.28ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.00 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. However The Oval-shaped, faceted cut diamond, has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Gemological Institute of America, Certificate no.6302954172 Dated October, 25, 2018. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 6302954172. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
