Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and 14ct white gold, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, high half round, tapered band of 1.73mm width (at base) x 1.23mm depth, with open back settings.

Feature white gold top plate, with a central four claw setting, housing one oval corundum doublet, claw set. Surrounding is one row of ten round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is supported with a pierced decorative gallery, and is secured in between the extended and pointed shoulders of the plain and polished yellow gold band.



Polished finish.

Stamped 'illegible stamps' - acid tested as 18 carat gold and 14 carat gold.

The ring contains:

One claw set oval shaped corundum doublet, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 5.48mm(L) x 4.35mm(W) x 2.44mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.46ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Ten claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed). Dimensions (average) = 2.01mm(Dia) x 1.23mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.30ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.48 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.76ct Total Metal Weight = 3.33 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
