## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 9ct white gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, wide, low half round band of 6.40mm width (at base) x 1.05mm depth, with open back settings.

Feature eleven rows of single cut diamonds, spanning across the top of the band. There are a total of two hundred and twenty-six single cut diamonds, slightly graduating in size, largest to the centre, and pave set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish.

Stamped '375 GM 140' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size: O.

The ring contains:

Two Hundred And Twenty Six pave set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.98mm (diameter) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.24mm (diameter) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 7.98 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 1.50ct

Total Metal Weight = 7.68 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings.
