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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 10ct white gold, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.54mm width (at base) x 1.33mm depth, with a curved decorative underrail.

Feature central four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is two rows of diamonds, largest to the corners. The top plate is secured between the split shoulders, which are also set with diamonds. There are a total of fifty-six round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set.



Polished finish.

Stamped '10K 0.48 michael hill' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size: M.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 3.39mm(L) x 3.36mm(W) x 2.05mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.14ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Six claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.92mm(Dia) x 0.56mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.34mm(Dia) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.34ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.91 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.48ct Total Metal Weight = 2.81 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
