Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, diamond set, multistone ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.07mm width (at base) x 1.22mm depth, with open back (cut out) settings.

Feature central six claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The central setting is secured between the extended and rounded shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of five round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set.



Polished finish.

Stamped '750' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: K.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "J".

Dimensions = 4.67mm(Dia) x 2.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.39ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Ten channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.69 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.49ct Total Metal Weight = 2.59 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
