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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, 9ct white gold, gem set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.08mm width (at base) x 1.12mm depth, with an open back settings, and a cut out curved underrail.

Feature central pear shaped top plate, housing eleven round brilliant cut diamonds, varying in size, largest to the centre, claw set. Surrounding is one row of twenty-five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between the tri-split style shoulders. Each of the shoulders houses one row of four round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, and channel. Each of the rails houses one row of nineteen round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, claw set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish. Stamped '375 W071 JP02' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: O.

The ring contains:

Fourteen claw and channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.05mm(Dia) x 1.25mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.94mm(Dia) x 1.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Sixty Eight claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.05mm(Dia) x 0.64mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.30mm(Dia) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.81 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.50ct Total Metal Weight = 5.51 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
