Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, multistone, gem set ring.

Plain, narrow, tapered band of 8.00mm at top to 3.19mm in width (at base) x 1.05mm depth, with a large pieced 'oval' design underrail, hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature three row ring design, consisting of nine round brilliant cut diamonds, largest tapering in size, channel set. The outer rows, each having seventeen round brilliant cut diamonds, slightly tapering in size, bead set. Rhodium plating to the setting areas.



Polished finish - stamped '9K' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size is T 1/2.

The ring contains:

Nine channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si, P1 & P2' (mixed), colour 'H to I' (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.65mm(Dia) x 1.06mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.06mm(Dia) x 1.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.60ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty Four bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'P1 & P2' (mixed), colour 'H to J' (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.35mm(Dia) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.50mm(Dia) x 0.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.27 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct - Total Metal Weight = 4.07 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
