Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 18ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring. Plain, narrow, tapered band of 3.21mm in width (at base) x 1.39mm depth, with a curved underrail, and open back (drilled) shoulders settings.

Feature central four claw railed setting, housing one round brilliant cut laboratory grown synthetic diamond, claw set. Secured between the extended shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having twenty-two round brilliant cut diamonds, in a double row, split design.

Polished finish - stamped '18ct' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size is R 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut laboratory grown synthetic diamond, clarity 'Si2', colour 'E'.

Dimensions = 6.53mm(L) x 6.49mm(W) x 4.01mm(D-estimated) x 4.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.07ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Forty Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Vs, Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'G to H' (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.25mm to 1.35mm(Dia) x 0.75mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.43ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.34 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 1.50ct - Total Metal Weight = 6.04 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The centre laboratory grown synthetic diamond has been certified by Messrs. International Gemological Institute (IGI) Certificate number: LG514291320 Dated: February 01, 2022. The laboratory grown synthetic diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with LABGROWN IGI and LG514291320. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the shoulder diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the shoulder diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the shoulder diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
