Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 10ct white gold, multi-stone ring set. The set comprising a 10ct white gold diamond set engagement ring, with a fitted and matching 10ct white gold wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, low half round band, with a combined basal width of 6.27mm x 1.20mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a central four claw setting, housing one square cut and faceted treated black diamond type material, claw set. Surrounded by twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, also claw set. The base being of a fine multi-wire support. All secured between the 'ramp' style shoulders of the plain and polished band. Fitted and matching wedding ring having a cut-out to one side at the centre top. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish - stamped '10ct 14K 585 37 D0.19ct' (on engagement ring), '10K michael) hill' (on wedding ring) - acid tested as approximately 10 carat gold. Finger size is Q.

The ring contains:

One claw set Princess cut treated black diamond type material.

Dimensions = 5.45mm(L) x 5.45mm(W) x 5.11mm(D-estimated) x 3%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.25ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'P3', colour 'H to I' (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.05mm(Dia) x 0.61mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.13ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.20 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 1.38ct - Total Metal Weight = 5.93 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The black gemstone may possibly be treated black diamond or treated synthetic black moissanite. Limited testing, whilst set, cannot determine the nature of these gemstones. Therefore, the black gemstones require removal from their settings for full and accurate gemmological testing. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
