## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and 18ct white gold, diamond set, multistone ring, of handmade construction.

Plain, narrow, flat, tapered band of 1.86mm width (at base) x 0.58mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central row of five yellow gold with white gold tipped settings, each housing one old cut diamond, claw set. The diamonds graduate in size, largest to the centre. The settings are secured to the top of the plain and polished yellow gold band.



Polished finish. Stamped '18K' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: O 1/2.

The ring contains:

Three claw set old cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.50mm(L) x 2.50mm(W) x 1.53mm(D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.99mm(L) x 2.99mm(W) x 1.82mm(D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.22ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two claw set old cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.25mm(L) x 2.25mm(W) x 1.37mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.08ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.94 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.30ct Total Metal Weight = 2.88 grams (estimated)
