Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item I

One, 18ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, 'three stone' style ring, of cast construction

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 1.90mm width (at base) x 1.31mm depth, and with open back settings.

Feature three bezel settings, spanning across the top of the band, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond. The diamonds graduate in size, largest to the centre, and are end set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. The shoulders are embellished with 'strap' detail. Rhodium plating to the central settings.



Polished finish.

Stamped '750' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: N.

The ring contains:

One end set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "H"

Dimensions = 5.26mm(Dia) x 3.34mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.57ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two end set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2", colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 3.73mm(Dia) x 2.35mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.42 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.97ct Total Metal Weight = 5.23 grams (estimated)
