Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct white gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow band of 2.38mm width (at base) x 1.21mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central cluster comprising five baguette cut diamonds, varying in size, and four round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Surrounding is two rows of round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The top plate is secured between the 'split' style shoulders, extending out from the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses two rows of round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, claw set. There are a total of sixty-eight round brilliant cut diamonds.



Polished finish. Stamped '375' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: J 1/2.
