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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's hand finished raised, 18ct yellow gold & diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measure 2.16mm width (at base) x 1.28mm depth, with curved underrail, open back settings, underneath. Feature, solitaire style" ring design, with shoulder & undercarraig wall stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting, rhodium plated to highlight, houses one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set, & two round brilliant cut diamonds, rub-over set, to each side wall. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up, each shoulder contains one baguette cut diamond, end set, & one round brilliant cut diamond, rubover set, both shoulders.



Polished finish, stamped "18K 750, KQ" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = Q.

The ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "H", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.87mm (average diameter) x 2.36mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.22ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Four rub-over set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "H", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.42mm (average diameter) x 0.87mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.29mm (average diameter) x 1.40mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Two end set baguette diamonds, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.08mm (L) x 1.84mm (W) x 1.34mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 3.62 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.46ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.53 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
