One, hand-assembled, 14ct white gold, diamond set pendant.

Feature multi-diamond 'drop' style pendant with bail, housing three hundred round brilliant cut diamonds, and ninety-nine baguette cut and tapered baguette cut (mixed) diamonds, tapering in size, end set.

Polished finish - stamped '14K DDG' - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

Pendant dimensions = 39.00mm (length including bail) x 26.00mm (width).

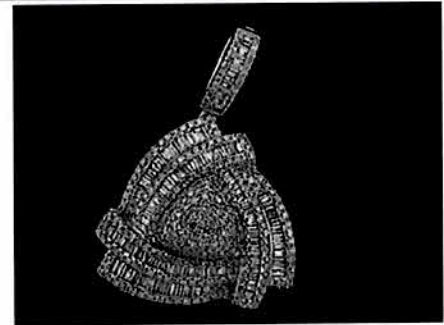

Three Hundred claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'H to J' (mixed).
Dimensions (average) = 0.90mm(Dia) x 0.55mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Ninety Nine end set baguette cut & tapered baguette cut (mixed) diamonds, clarity 'Si & P1' (mixed), colour 'H to I' (mixed).
Dimensions = 1.50mm(L) x 0.60mm(W) x 0.30mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)
Dimensions = 1.70mm(L) x 0.90mm(W) x 0.45mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)
Total Weight = 1.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 8.46 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 2.00ct - Total Metal Weight = 8.06 grams (estimated)

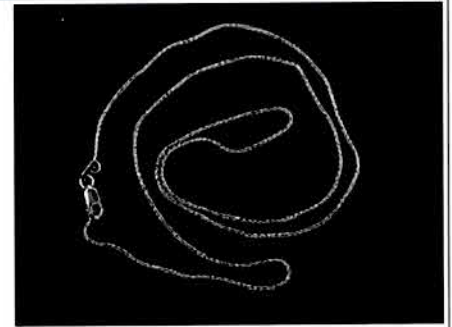
