One lady's, hand-assembled raised, 18ct white gold & diamond set, cluster dress ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures, 2.46mm width (at base) x 1.26mm depth, with

Feature, "cluster style" ring design, with shoulder stones, Comprising a raised four claw setting to centre. Drops to an open circular suround, housing, twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up to the top, from both sides. each shoulder contains five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set.



Polished finish, stamped "Au750, FI3, 1.00, d0.219ct" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = L.

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "F", medium cut quality. Dimensions = 6.28mm - 6.32mm (diameter) x 3.98mm (D-actual) x 4.5%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 1.00ct (known weight - see NOTE below).

Thirty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.22mm (average diameter) x 0.74mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.56mm (average diameter) x 0.95mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.21ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 3.72 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.21ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.48 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The round brilliant cut diamond, has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Gemological Institute of America, Certificate no.1136442329 Dated; May 27,2011. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds, cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds, are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds, require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
