Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, multistone ring, of cast construction.

Plain, wide, low half round, tapered band of 5.09mm width (at base) x 0.83mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature four rows of mixed, round brilliant cut diamonds, and gemstones, spanning half way across the top of the band, and bead set. The rows are embellished with open loop detail, spanning the other half of the top of the band. There are a total of thirteen round brilliant cut diamonds, two natural round emeralds, four natural round sapphires, and one round cubic zirconia. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish. Stamped '18K' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: P 1/2.

The ring contains:

Thirteen bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, and one round synthetic cubic zirconia, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.70mm(Dia) x 1.04mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.40mm(Dia) x 1.46mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.77ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two bead set round natural emeralds, colour is "green".

Dimensions (average)= 2.50mm(Dia) x 1.53mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Bulge)

Total Weight = 0.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Four bead set round natural sapphires, colour is "blue".

Dimensions = 1.80mm(Dia) x 1.10mm(D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.14ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings.
