Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, 'cluster' style dress ring, of handmade construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 3.18mm width (at base) x 1.22mm depth, with hollow shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature central bezel setting, housing one natural oval ruby cabochon, bezel set. Surrounding are seven individual bezel settings, evenly spaced around the central setting, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond, bezel set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band.

Polished finish.

Unstamped - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: P 1/2.

The ring contains:

One bezel set oval shaped natural ruby cabochon, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 8.55mm(L) x 6.77mm(W) x 3.73mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 2.25ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Seven bezel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.73mm(Dia) x 1.67mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.53ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.13 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 2.78ct Total Metal Weight = 4.57 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. Some of the bezel settings are very worn. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
