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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, gem set, 'dress' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 3.17mm width (at base) x 1.22mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature central four claw setting, housing one fancy cabochon with a faceted pavillion natural topaz, claw set. The setting is secured between the 'split' style shoulders, extending out from the plain and polished band. The shoulders wrap around to a 'knot' design in the gallery. The shoulders and gallery, are embellished with a total of two hundred and seventy-four round brilliant cut diamonds, varying in size, and pave set.



Polished finish. Stamped '750 157 unknown makers mark' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: Q. Ring size: Q.

The ring contains:

One claw set mixed cut fancy cabochon with a faceted pavillion natural topaz "blue".

Dimensions = 13.97mm(L) x 12.06mm(W) x 8.39mm(D-estimated) x 20%(Bulge)

Forty Three claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.02mm(Dia) x 0.62mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.20mm(Dia) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.30ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two Hundred And Thirty One claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, colour is "black".

Dimensions = 1.1mm(Dia) x 0.67mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.31mm(Dia) x 0.8mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.85ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 9.46gm

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
