## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, multi-stone, ring set, of cast construction.

The set comprising a 9ct yellow gold diamond set engagement ring with a fitted and matching 9ct yellow gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 3.55mm x 1.17mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a 'flower' style top plate, housing seven round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The setting is secured to the underrail. One of the shoulders curls around the central setting and houses one row of six round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set. The other shoulder houses one row of eight tapered baguette cut diamonds, channel set. Rhodium plating to the central setting.



The fitted and matching wedding ring also has one shoulder that curls around the central setting, and houses one row of six round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set. The other shoulder houses one row of eight tapered baguette cut diamonds, channel set. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.

Polished finish. Stamped '750 AC16' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: L & L 1/2.

The ring contains:

Nineteen channel and claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.13mm(Dia) x 0.69mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.18mm(Dia) x 1.33mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.43ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Sixteen channel set tapered baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs", colour is "I to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.20mm(L) x 0.90mm(W) x 0.66mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.90mm(L) x 0.84mm(W) x 0.61mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.16ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.43 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.59ct Total Metal Weight = 6.31 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
