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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 10ct rose gold and rhodium plated, cluster style, gem set, dress ring.

Plain, narrow, tapered band of 2.17mm in width (at base) x 1.30mm in depth, with curved underrail, hollow and open at the shoulders.

Feature central 'cluster' style setting, housing seven round brilliant cut diamonds, largest to the outside, claw set. Surrounded by a single row of eighteen single cut diamonds, also claw set. All secured between the extended shoulders of the plain and polished band.

Polished finish - stamped '10CT MHJ 0.15' - acid tested as approximately 10 carat gold. Finger size is O.

The ring contains:

Seven claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si, P1 & P2' (mixed), colour 'H to I' (mixed).
Dimensions = 1.35mm(Dia) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)
Dimensions = 1.50mm(Dia) x 0.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Eighteen claw set single cut diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'H to I' (mixed).
Dimensions = 0.80mm (ave. diameter)
Total Weight = 0.05ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.25 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.15ct - Total Metal Weight = 2.22 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
