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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand assembled, 14ct white / rose gold, multi-stone, ring set, of cast construction.

The set comprising a 14ct white gold and 14ct rose gold diamond set engagement ring with a fitted and matching 14ct white gold diamond set wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 3.41mm x 1.20mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a central four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounding is one row of twelve round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Each of the extended and pointed shoulders, in a 'wrap around' style, houses a cluster of three round brilliant cut diamonds, and one row of eight round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, all claw set. Framing the row of diamonds is a decorative tapering rose gold wire.



The fitted and matching wedding ring, has one row of twnety one round brilliant cut diamonds, spanning across the top of the band, slightly graduating in size, and claw set. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.

Polished finish. Stamped '14K MHJ 0.23TDW 0.75TDW' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: P 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P2", colour is "H".

Dimensions = 3.96mm(Dia) x 2.44mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.24ct

Fifty Five claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.99mm(Dia) x 0.60mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.78mm(Dia) x 1.09mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.74ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.04 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.98ct Total Metal Weight = 5.85 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
