## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, lady's 2pce set, hand finished raised, 14ct white gold & gemset, multistone rings. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered bands, measure a combined basal width 3.30mm x 1.62mm depth, with curved underrails.

Feature, "2pce ring set". Comprising, a cluster style ring, & a contured fitted band. The cluster houses one pear-shaped, faceted diamond to top, claw set. drops to a double shaped surround, housing thirty nine round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up, splits at the top, each shoulder contains, nine round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, both sides. The contured fitted band, has a single curved row, runns across the top, contains eighteen round brilliant cut diamond, claw set.



Polished finish, stamped "14k, 0.81, michael hill, 14k 0.19, micahel hill" - acid tested both as 14 carat gold.

Finger size = T.

The ring contains;

One claw set pear-shaped, diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "H", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 5.43mm (L) x 3.32mm (W) x 2.03mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.23ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Seventy Five claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si, P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.30mm (average diameter) x 0.79mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm (average diameter) x 0.98mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.77ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.37 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct, Total Metal Weight = 6.17 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamonds, would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar 2pc ring set, employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
