Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, multistone pendant, of handmade construction.

Feature central bezel setting, housing one oval opal cabochon, bezel set. Framing the central setting is an assymetrical panel, housing twenty-eight round brilliant cut diamonds, varying in size, and bead set. The pendant is finished with a fixed, hinged tapered bail.

Pendant dimensions = 28.00mm (ave. length) x 17.51mm (ave. width) x 4.84mm (ave. depth).

Polished finish.

Unstamped.

The pendant contains:

One bezel set oval opal cabochon, colour is "blue, purple, and green".

Dimensions = 15.00mm(L) x 11.70mm(W) x 4.53mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 4.44ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Eight bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.55mm(Dia) x 0.95mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.73mm(Dia) x 1.06mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.45ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.56 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 4.89ct Total Metal Weight = 3.58 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The central stone is an opal type doublet, and would need to be unset for for full gemmological testing and verification. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar pendant employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
