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## Valuation For Traditional Insurance Replacement Purposes

### Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 18ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring.

Plain, wide, low half round band of 3.02mm in width (at base) x 1.62mm depth.

Feature four 'corner' claw, railed setting, housing one Princess cut diamond, corner set. The setting is secured in the top of the plain and polished band, with each shoulder having five round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering in size, claw set.

Polished finish - stamped '18K' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size is L 1/2.

The ring contains:

One corner set Princess cut diamond, clarity 'Vs2', colour 'brown', medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 5.33mm(L) x 5.28mm(W) x 3.50mm(D-estimated) x 3%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.70ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Ten claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Vs & Si' (mixed), colour 'H', medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.70mm(Dia) x 1.00mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.40mm(Dia) x 1.40mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.30ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.26 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct - Total Metal Weight = 5.04 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
