Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 9ct yellow gold and 9ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring.

Plain, wide band of 3.89mm in width (at base) x 0.68mm depth.

Feature three individual white gold four claw settings, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond, tapering in size, claw set. To one side is a double multi-claw setting, housing two single cut diamonds (smallest). All mounted atop the yellow gold plain and polished band.

Polished finish - stamped '9CT' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size is T.

The ring contains:

One end set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'Si', colour 'G'.

Dimensions = 4.07mm(Dia) x 2.48mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.25ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Four claw set round brilliant cut & single cut (mixed) diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'T'.

Dimensions = 0.80mm(Dia) x 0.49mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.60mm(Dia) x 1.59mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.11ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.98 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.36ct - Total Metal Weight = 2.91 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the
