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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand-assembled raised, 18ct white gold & diamond set, cluster dress ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measure 2.05mm width (at base) x 1.31mm depth, with curved underrail.

Feature; "cluster style" ring design. Comprising, a raised three claw setting to top. Drops to a double surround, containing thirty five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The undercarriage, contains twelve small round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up wide, splits to a v-style termination. Each shoulder house twenty two round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set, both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "18K, Michelle Beville" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = M.

the ring contains;

One claw set pear-shaped, faceted, diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "F", very good cut quality.

Dimensions = 6.59mm (L) x 4.12mm (W) x 2.48mm (D-actual) x 4%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.40ct (known weight- see NOTE below).

Ninety One claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si, P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.07mm (average diameter) x 0.65mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.35mm (average diameter) x 0.82mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.82ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.12 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.22ct, Total Metal Weight = 5.88 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. The pear cut diamond has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. International Gemological Institute, Certificate no. 487188987. Dated July 28, 2021. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with IGI (logo) and 487188987. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds, cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds, are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds, require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
