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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, diamond set, multistone ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.83mm width (at base) x 1.23mm depth, with open back settings.

Feature central six claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The setting is secured between the extended and square shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of seven round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, and channel set.



Polished finish. Stamped '18K WG D0.15' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: I.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "F".

Dimensions = 5.24mm(L) x 5.22mm(W) x 3.20mm(D-estimated) x 3.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.54ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Fourteen channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.10mm(Dia) x 0.67mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.50mm(Dia) x 0.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.15ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.68 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.69ct Total Metal Weight = 2.54 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by Messrs. Gemological Institute of America (GIA) Certificate number: 2146754930 Dated: March 09, 2013. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 2146754930. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
