Item 1

One, hand-assembled, platinum and 18 carat white gold, multistone ring set. The set comprising a platinum ruby and diamond set engagement ring, with a fitted and matching 18ct white gold ruby and diamond set eternity ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow band with a combined basal width of 3.93mm x 0.90mm in depth. The platinum engagement ring has a central four claw setting, housing one oval cut and faceted natural ruby, claw set. Surrounded by individual two claw settings, housing fourteen round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Decorative pierced 'scroll' design work to the base, all secured between the extended and tri-split shoulders of the plain and polished band. The fitted and matching 18 carat white gold eternity ring having two round cut and faceted natural rubies, alternating with three round brilliant cut diamonds, all secured in four claw settings. To each end is a 'leaf' design plate, all mounted atop the plain and polished band. The eternity ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish - stamped 'PT.900 0.40' & engraved '112145 7205' (on engagement ring,) '750 X M HANDWROUGHT(partial), engraved '9205' (on eternity ring) - acid tested. Finger size is S 1/2.

The ring contains:

- One claw set mixed cut oval-shape natural ruby, colour 'medium dark red'.
Dimensions = 4.86mm(L) x 4.18mm(W) x 1.75mm(D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below)
- Two claw set round cut and faceted natural rubies, colour 'medium dark red'.
Dimensions (average) = 2.30mm(Dia) x 1.40mm(D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.11ct (estimated - see NOTE below)
- Seventeen claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'SI', colour 'G'.
Dimensions = 1.70mm(Dia) x 1.04mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)
Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.36ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 8.47 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.87ct - Total Metal Weight = 8.29 grams estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
